Wednesday, March 14th from 11:30am to 10:00pm. 20% of proceeds raised will go directly to WGB.

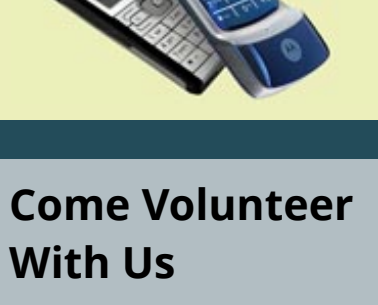

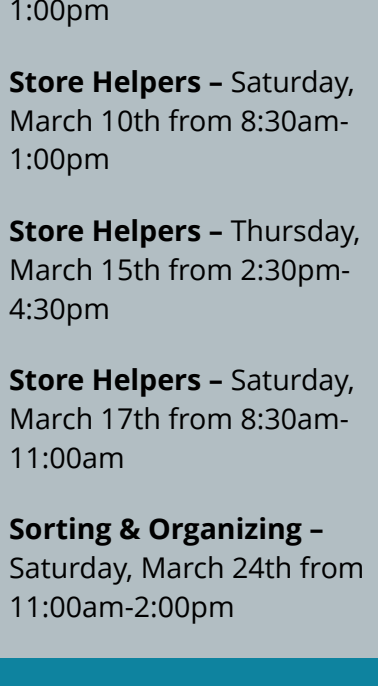

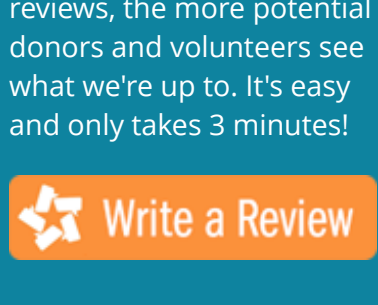
