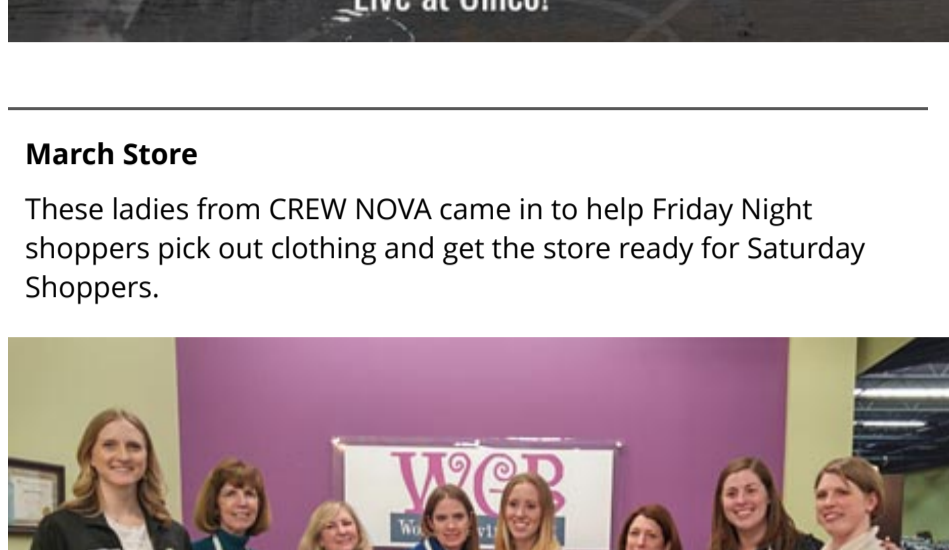

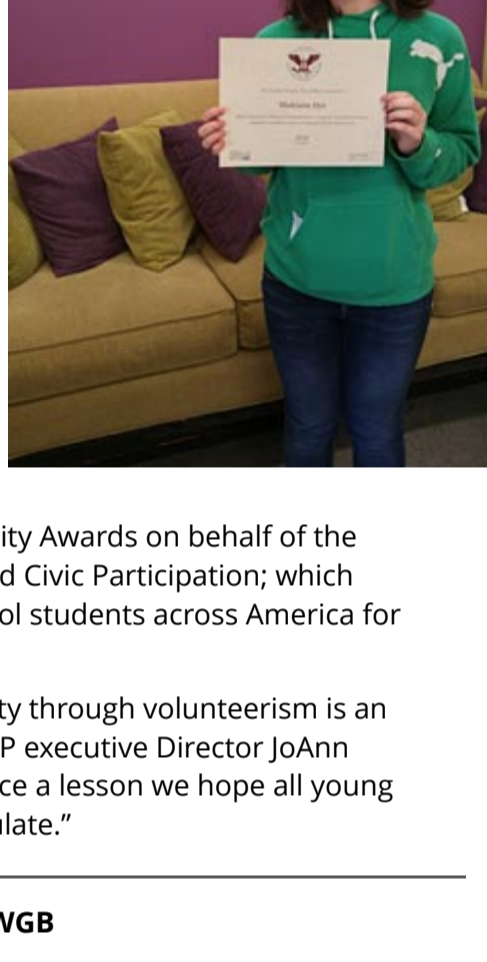


President's Volunteer Service Award

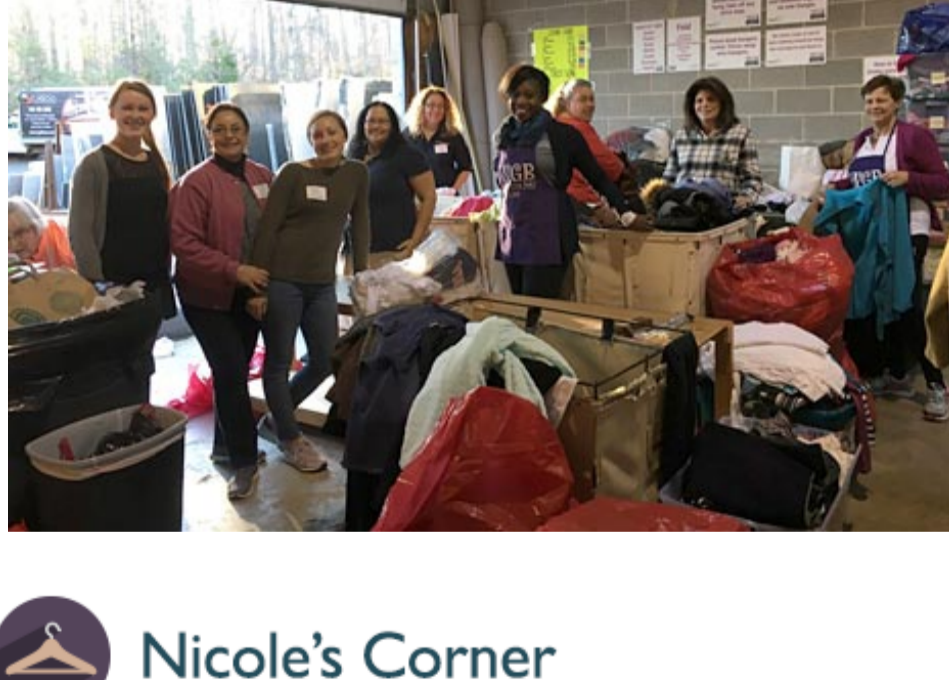

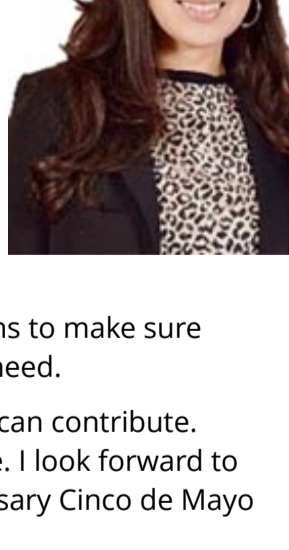
Nicole's Corner

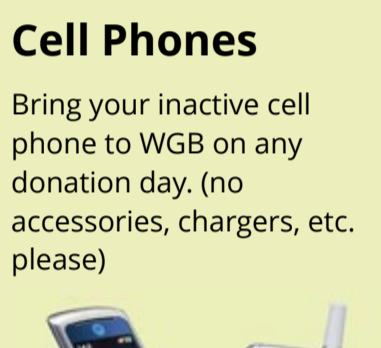

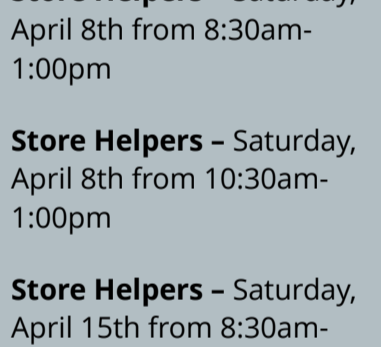
