

WGB's Bag to Go Program started in 2016 because of the emergency need of clothing that our client's were facing. Bag to Go request forms are submitted by Case Managers / Social Workers and FBI Victim Service Agents who provides information on the client's clothing and shoe sizes and picks up the bag when it is done. A volunteer "shops" for the client, putting together full outfits from our boutique, picking out jewelry, purses and toiletries. These bags are packed with so much love for a person they will probably never meet. Sometimes we have only a 48 hour turnaround time to prepare Bag To Go Orders, so having volunteers like Liz and Cheryl we can call on to get it done has been essential to making this program successful. 
